newly refurbished Glove Factory in Yeovil this year as part of the Diamond Jubilee Tour (2012). This former factory is now part of a Zero Carbon Living Development and is used as commercial and office space. We are proud to say that the Cast Iron Windows in the Grade II listed Building were fully repaired and refurbished by our company. The Glove Factory was built in the 1870's for Ewen's and Johnson Ltd and used for many years to make gloves, and is now finely preserved for future

generations.

The windows were carefully removed from site and

returned to our factory in Derbyshire, where they were 'stripped' back to bare iron, any missing parts re-cast and welded into place, opening mechanisms replaced with new and finally painting completed this process. The fully refurbished windows were then carefully packed in foam sheets and specifically made cradles ready for transportation.
